


1. When used according to the access power line, one end is inserted into the socket at the bottom of the piano operation plate. The other end is inserted into the 220V household power socket (Figure 1)

#### 2 AUDIO INPUT / OUTPUT PLUG

1. The audio output socket can be connected to large sound box equipment.

2. The audio input socket connects the external sound source to the electric piano for playback. (Figure 2)

#### **3** MIDI INPUT AND OUTPUT SOCKET

The MIDI interface of this digital piano can be connected to music equipment with MIDI.(Figure 3)

#### 4 USB TRANSPORT INTERFACE

Using the USB transmission interface to connect with the computer Through the computer installed Music software, to learn or play the keyboard to play, composition, storage and other functional operations. Edited music and built-in accompaniment to music software. It can be played by software connected to the digital piano or played by accompaniment music (Figure 4)

#### 5 DOUBLE HEADSET SOCKET

The headphone jack is located at the bottom left of the piano, when the headphones are connected, it will automatically cut off the output of the built-in speaker, so that it will not disturb others when playing. This product has two headphone jacks so you can plug in two headphones at the same time. (Figure 5)

#### 6 PEDAL SOCKET

The foot pedal connector is located on the bottom left of the piano. Insert the end of the pedal line into the circular socket of the bottom of the piano, and you can connect the 3 pedal sound effects .In turn : weak tone, posterior extension and portamento (Figure 6)

8 DOUBLE KEYBOARD

1. First enter the timbre mode and choose an instrument as the main timbre. 2. Press the "SPLIT" button to enter the split timbre selection mode. (Figure 10)

3. Use the "NUMERICAL SELECT" rotation to select another instrument as the segmented timbre. (Figure 4) 4. Play music on the keyboard, and then play the corresponding instrument sounds on both sides of the keyboard. 5. Press the "SPLIT" button again, cancel the keyboard segmentation, and return to the normal keyboard state.

## TRANSPOSITION

Press the "TRANS" button, then use the "NUMERICAL SELECT" rotation to adjust the keyboard tone, to the left to

reduce, to the right to increase. Adjustment range: 12 semitones. (Figure 11 / 4)

## 10 MP3 PLAY FUNCTION

1. Insert the flash disk containing MP3 songs into "USB SOCKET" and play MP3

songs automatically after 3 seconds. (Figure 12) 2. Press the "PLAY" button to pause or play MP3 songs. (Figure 13) 3. Press the control button of "Selection/-Volume+" in a short time to select the

front/back MP3 songs. (Figure 14) 4. Pressing the "Selection/-Volume+" control button for a long time can adjust

the volume of the song. (Figure 14) Maximum peak sound, need to turn the "VOLUME" knob control.

## 1 PIANO PERFORMANCE

1. Push the "POWER" switch to the open position, and you can play on the keyboard. (Figure 1)  $\,$ 2. Turn off the power supply when not in use for the time being.

1. Press the "TONE" button to enter the instrument timbre selection mode. (Figure 3) 2. Rotate "NUMERICAL SELECT" to select the timbre of the instrument, and display the code and name of the instrument. (Figure 4)

## **6** DOUBLE TIMBRE


## 7 DYNAMIC TOUCH CONTROL

The function of dynamic tactile response is that the volume will produce the corresponding volume according to the power

of playing the keyboard, which is convenient for playing music with different feelings.

1. Hold down the "EFFECT" button, and press the "white key C1" in track 2 area to start track 2 recording. (Figure 15)



## 12 METRONOME

1. Hold down the "EFFECT" button and press the "white key F1" to start and close the metronome. (Figure 15) 2. Hold down the "EFFECT" button and press a corresponding "white key G1-C" in the metronomic selection area to select

the metronomic type. There are four types.

3. Hold down the "EFFECT" button and press a corresponding "white key F-G" in the speed regulation area to adjust the metronome speed.

## 13 DOUBLE TIMBRE

1. First enter the timbre mode and choose an instrument as the main timbre.

2. Press the "EFFECT" button while pressing the "white key E" to start the dual tone selection mode. (Figure 15)

3. Select another instrument as superimposed timbre by rotating "NUMERICAL SELECT" (Figure 4) 4. At this time, playing the keyboard emits a mixed sound of two instruments.

5. Press the "EFFECT" button again while pressing the "white key E", cancel the dual tone function and return to the normal keyboard state.

## 14 DIGITAL SOUND CONTROL

1. Pressing the "EFFECT" button while holding down the "white key A" in the sound effect area can turn on or off the tremolo effect. (Figure 15)

2. Pressing the "EFFECT" button while holding down the "White Key B" in the sound effect area can turn on or off the

1. Press the "EFFECT" button while pressing the "white key c" to switch the scale keyboard to the percussion instrument

2. Press the "EFFECT" button again while pressing the "white key c", then turn off this function.


